Dear Parent/Guardian,

We have reached the end of another busy year and I would like to take this opportunity to thank you for the support you have given both to your son and to the school. You will see from our newsletter which we distributed last week that we have had many reasons to celebrate this term. We have recently had more good news as our pupils won the Smithfield Market Design competition. This is an amazing achievement as the pupils were against 3 other schools in the final. Once the buildings are completed the school will have a plaque in the middle of the markets which will have the school name showing that the pupils helped design the area. This is very exciting and pupils who took part should be very proud of themselves. Two of our pupils have also been working hard, Mohammed Yusuf Hadi (Y11) and Mikail Hussain (Y9) who have completed the memorisation of the Quran. Congratulation to both. Students also took part in the Darood challenge and completed 2 million prayers as a salutation to the Prophet (pbuh).

As we look forward to the start of a New Year and New Term, I would like to re-iterate how fundamental attendance is to your son’s progress and achievement. 100% attendance is expected for all pupils in all subjects, currently the school attendance rate is 98.2%. Please note that leave of absence will not be authorised in any circumstances and if your son is absent for more than 2 weeks it will result in him being taken off roll. Please also make sure that your son arrives to school on time.

As we continue to endure the winter months, we ask parents to ensure their sons are dressed as per the school uniform policy, students are only permitted to wear black or blue overcoats. Students should also maintain the highest standards when wearing their school uniform. If you have any queries, the Parent Handbook contains a list of the full school uniform. I would also like to re-iterate that **extreme haircuts** are not allowed in school. If your son is having his hair cut in the holiday, please ensure it is appropriate for school. May I also request that if your son is in Year 11 and attends the Sunday school you ensure all payments have been made through Parent Pay and that you are up to date by the end of the holiday.

School closes today and opens again on Tuesday 7th January at 8am. Please ensure your son is on school premises and ready for the start time of 8am. Your support in ensuring this happens is very much appreciated.
