Reopening of school to pupils in Year 10

I would like to thank you for your continued support during this difficult time and hope you and your family are well.

The Prime Minister announced on 24th May that schools will start to reopen to pupils in Year 10 as from Monday 15th June, to enable pupils to have some 'face to face contact' with their teachers before the end of the academic year. Pupils will attend school in small groups and rigorous hygiene measures will be applied.

The school are working hard to uphold the Government's guidance and ensure that your son receives the support that he needs at this critical point in his education, and ensure that the school is as safe as possible for all pupils and staff. The safety and wellbeing of everyone in the Star community is of paramount importance to us.

We will write to you again within the next fortnight to confirm specific arrangements that we are making for reopening. In the meantime, please encourage your son to continue with his studies by attending online lessons and completing the work set by his teachers.

Free school meals provision

All pupils who are eligible for benefits-related free school meals will continue to receive vouchers through the Government's Edenred scheme. The next free school meal vouchers will be issued for the four-week period starting from 1st June.

Please update us

School has remained open for the children of key workers, and for other specific children, during the period of lockdown. If you are a key worker and require a place for your child/children (in any year group) to enable you to return to work, please contact Eden Boys' School, Birmingham, Wellhead Lane, Perry Barr. so that arrangements can be made. (Parents of pupils who are already attending school daily do not need to reapply.)

Thank you once again for helping us support your son. I am very proud of the way in which our Star community has pulled together to look after each other during the pandemic.

As you know, Star Academies is running a campaign to support families who may be struggling to afford essential food and hygiene products during this period. If you need help, please let us know as we are here for you.
