Dear Parent/Guardian,

Assalaamu Alaikum – ‘Peace be upon you’

RE: No Mobile Phone Policy

As you are aware, students are not permitted to bring mobile phones into school unless their parents or guardians have requested special permission for them to do so. Permission will only be granted in instances where students require the use of a mobile phone on their journey to and from school for safeguarding/welfare purposes. Permission must be obtained in writing from the school and students should not bring in a mobile phone until this has been received.

Students who have been given permission to bring a mobile phone to school are required to hand their phone in to Reception at the start of the school day and collect it at the end of the day. They are asked to sign a log confirming that they have safely dropped off and picked up their phone. Students are not permitted to keep a mobile phone in their possession during the school day and any student found with a phone will be disciplined in line with the school’s Behaviour Policy and Rewards and Sanctions procedure. The phone will be confiscated and the student’s parent/guardian will be asked to collect it

Our school takes stringent measures to ensure the privacy of our students and staff is protected and prohibiting the use of mobile phones helps to keep everyone in our school community safe, happy and well. Without the constant distraction of their mobile phones, students can focus more on their lessons and, as a result, their grades often improve.

We therefore ask that, if your child has been given permission to bring a mobile phone into school, you remind them of the rules set out overleaf. Breaking these rules can put all our students and staff at risk – and may prevent us from allowing students to bring in mobile phones, even in exceptional circumstances.

If you need to contact your child throughout the school day, please feel free to call the School Office – your message will be passed on to your child as soon as we receive the call.

May I also take this opportunity to remind you that, if your child has been given permission to bring a mobile phone into school, they do so at their own risk. The school will not accept liability for lost, damaged or stolen phones.

Mobile Phone Rules

As a student who has been given permission to bring your mobile phone into school, you must follow each of the rules listed below.

1. You are not allowed to bring a mobile phone to school unless your parents have requested and received permission - in writing - from the school.
2. You must hand in your mobile phone to a member of the Reception staff at the start of the school day.
3. It is important to remember that your mobile phone is left in school at your own risk.
4. Only you can drop off or pick up your mobile phone - another student cannot drop it off or collect it on your behalf.
5. You must sign a sheet every day to confirm that you have dropped off and picked up your phone.
6. If you have an intervention/detention, you must collect your phone from reception
7. You must be discreet about having your phone in school. For example, you should not show your phone to other students before you drop it off or after you pick it up.
8. You must not allow other students to use your phone.
9. You are not allowed to take a picture or make a recording on the school site. This also applies if you are on the school bus or if you are in school for holiday or after-school intervention classes.
10. Even when you aren't on the school site, you are not allowed to upload any images or videos made of students in their uniforms.
11. You must not take or share images/videos of others without their permission.
